1. Take Exit 119 off of I-5.
2. Turn right onto Dupont-Steilacoom Rd.
3. Turn right at the gate into the museum parking lot (there are now signs).
4. Park in the parking lot and phone the museum front desk at 253-967-7206.
5. You will be escorted through the gate to the museum on foot.

When your visit has concluded, you will be escorted back to the parking lot.
